MULTI-FAMILY CONDOMINIUM BUILDING IN CINCINNATI, OHIO

The Challenge:

A Cincinnati condo developer needed a modern railing for a building's rooftop decks, second floor balconies, and street-level entrances. The railing needed to maintain its look over time, weather uniformly, and not block views while meeting commercial code and staying within budget.

The Solution:

Using Key-Link vertical cable railing on balconies gave residents accessible views and helped give the small balconies an open feeling, while using a lower-cost traditional railing on the street level and on the roof helped keep the project in budget. Since the railing all came from the same manufacturer, the developer knew it would weather uniformly over time. As required, all the railing also met commerical code requirements.
