RENOVATED BARN RESTAURANT AND MUSICE VENUE IN HUMMELSTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA

The Challenge:

A developer wanted to turn a traditional 1861 barn into a mid-size music venue and restaurant, creating an upscale rustic aesthetic and keeping many of the barn's original elements through restoration and repurposing. The railing, which was needed both indoors and out, had to allow for clear sight lines, especially inside for performances, fit the aesthetic, and meet commercial code requirements.



The Solution:

Key-Link's vertical cable worked both indoors and out for a seamless transition, open sight lines, and fit the upscale rustic style of the renovated barn. All met commercial code requirments and gave tables on the second story interior a clear view of the performers on stage.
