RESTAURANT DECK, STAIRS, RAMP, AND PLAYGROUND IN LANCASTER, PENNSYLVANIA

The Challenge:

Fox Meadows Creamery, a Lancaster County, PA, restaurant and ice cream shop, opened a second location with a modern farmhouse exterior and style. Because of their second story deck, ramps, stairs, and playground, their building required many feet of railing. In addition, the railing needed to a) fit the aesthetic of the building, b) maintain sight lines, and c) meet commercial code requirements.

The Solution:

Vertical cable from Key-Link Fencing & Railing met Fox Meadows' needs for a modern look that allowed open sight lines (especially for children on the small playground) and met code requirements for safety (especially on the second story deck). On their stairs and ramps, they added a fully-graspable ADA handrail in matching textured black.
